Light Behind the Darkness

A Patient's Story of Finding Dignity, Truth, and Hope at Connect

When Tarrense first walked into Connect Medical Clinic, he kept his hood up and his eyes to the ground. Life had worn him down. He didn't know who to trust, where to go, or even how to ask for help. "Before I heard about Connect Medical...it was on and off—mostly off. I didn't know nobody here. So it was hard to shout out to people 'cause I didn't know what to look for or where to go or who to ask," he shared.

But something shifted the day he met with the Connect Cares Coordinator for a Consultation. For the first time in his life, Tarrense felt seen. Heard. Safe. "I ain't never reached out to nobody to ever talk to anybody in my life... I always held it in. But at Connect, it's just like talking to your best friend. That's how they make you feel."

What started as a routine check-up turned into a turning point. "I just wanted to make sure I was still healthy... but then we started talking about myself and stuff, and I started telling them how I was coming up. And they just listened."

He opened up. And life began to change.

"They showed me that I matter. That there's always someone there that will take time out of their day to make sure my day is going well," he said. "Once I started seeing things more clear, the body followed. I started talking more and laughing more and feeling better. My gray sky started letting sunlight through."

The ConnectED Life Skills

Pathway became a lifeline—
providing tools, encouragement,
and real support. "Connect makes

you feel good in ways that make you always want to come back. It's a breath of fresh air just stepping in the door."

For Tarrense, it all came down to dignity. His outlook on life, his confidence in being a father to his grown sons and newborn daughter, his understanding of God and His purpose for him all resulted in a visible transformation. More than once, staff noted the change in him—before he even said a word. "They really paid attention. And I love them for that."

Now, Tarrense is not just standing tall—he's reaching back to help others. "I've been in your situation before, and these people helped me. Now I'm a better person. So the least I can do is help somebody else get lifted too."

He shares one final message to all who make this care possible:

"I would say thank you to everybody who's donated... If I could shake everybody's hand, I would. Because if you only knew the change that y'all have done for me... it's big. And man—it's like the best feeling ever."

A Priceless Evening: Kelly Lester's Story and the Mission of Connect

At this year's Priceless Banquet, keynote speaker Kelly Lester delivered more than a testimony—she gave a voice to the kind of healing and hope that transcends politics and ideology. With humor, humility, and deep honesty, she shared her journey through trauma, abortion, addiction, and eventually, redemption.

Kelly spoke not from a place of judgment, but from lived experience—experience that included working inside the abortion industry, battling addiction, and believing that her story was beyond repair. But God, she said, met her not with shame, but with mercy. And through His grace, her identity was restored.

"What you have here at Connect," Kelly told the audience, "is unlike anything I've ever seen." She described Connect as the answer not only to the needs of women in crisis, but to the deeper cultural divide surrounding life, dignity, and healthcare.

Since the overturning of Roe v. Wade, she explained, both the pro-life and pro-choice movements have been asking hard questions—Why are abortion numbers still rising? What kind of care truly supports women? What does compassion look like in action?

"Connect is the answer to those questions," she said.

Not because it fits neatly into one side of a debate but because it lives out the dignity of every person patient and staff, parent and child—through consistent, relationship-based care.

"If I had walked into Connect at 15, 19, or 25," she shared, "my story might have been different. **You are the difference.**"

In a culture hungry for hope, Kelly reminded the audience that Connect doesn't just respond to needs—it builds something better. Her closing message was clear: God will provide for Connect. The question is—will you partner with what He's doing?
